UUFB Social Witness Policy

Adopted Jan 11, 2010

On behalf of the congregation, the UUFB Board of Directors may take positions and/or support activities that align with General Assembly Action Items and the Social Justice statements vetted and approved by the Unitarian Universalist Association and the UUA Commission on Social Witness (CSW) and the Unitarian Universalist Service Committee (UUSC).

Actions may include the use of our name, financial support, coordination of volunteers, assembling members and friends for marches, use of our facilities, or whatever is deemed appropriate by the Board. This policy is designed to promote the values of Unitarian Universalism within the wider community.

Other issues not falling within these parameters require a congregation vote to approve endorsement as per our by-laws. Actions and support will be consistent with the requirements of maintaining UUFB compliance with our 501(c)(3) status.
