


FULFILLING YOUR PLEDGE

You can fulfill your pledge through

- a single lump sum donation (a check sent with your pledge form or in a labeled envelope in the offering plate). If you pay by check, please put "pledge" in the memo line
- a regular (monthly, quarterly, etc.) payment: a check or directly from your bank's bill payment service.
- a stock transfer (contact our Office Admin)
- a direct transfer to UUFB as a Qualified Charitable Distribution from your IRA, thus reducing your taxable income, even if you do not itemize deductions. (Contact your IRA plan administrator and our Office Administrator.) Additional information is available here: uufbozeman.org/ira.
