The Social Justice Action Committee (SJAC) has specified that the offering will be saved for a future disaster. Once SJAC chooses a recipient for the offering, the funds will be sent to the charity. June 30 is the 5th Sunday of the month, so a special offering will be collected for response to a crisis or emergency. We anticipate a challenging fire season here in the west, and forecasters say this is likely to be an unusually active one for Atlantic hurricanes. So cash and specified checks in the offering on June 30 will be tracked through bookkeeping so the Fellowship has funds on hand to respond to an emergency in the coming months. The Social Justice Action Committee will identify the recipient of the funds and will inform the Fellowship as events unfold. Thank you for your generosity.
