The Social Justice Action Committee (SJAC) has specified that this offering will go to the Bozeman Senior Center Meals on Wheels. Donate online (uufbozeman.org/donate) and select “Give to 2nd Sunday charitable donation” or write a check payable to UUFB with “meals” in the memo line.

The Bozeman Senior Center's Meals on Wheels program provides nutritious home-delivered meals to qualifying homebound residents within Bozeman city limits. Participants may receive meals for a single day, a short recovery period, or on an ongoing basis, depending on their needs. Funding is provided through federal and state grants, along with participant contributions.
